GRADUATION



- 1 30 credits in total
- 2 40 hours of Community Involvement
- 3 Completion of the Literacy Requirement
- 4 Earn at least 2 Online Learning Credits

Graduation Requirements

Community Involvement

- 40 hours REQUIRED
- Be completed outside scheduled class time
- Not be a part of a credit course
- Be unpaid
- Be complete by the end of grade12

ONLINE LEARNING Requirement

- 2 Courses Required
- Must be Asynchronous
- Student may opt out by completing form
- Current Grade 12s: If you were in Ontario, one course from Quad 4 of grade 9 counts

Diploma & Awards

DIPLOMA

- Diploma
 - Complete all gradation requirements

Ontario Scholar

- 80% plus average in top 6 grade 12 classes
 - Final mark sum = 480 marks or higher

HONOUR ROLL

- 80% PLUS AVERAGE IN TOP 6 COURSES FROM JULY 1, 2023 TO JUNE 27, 2024
 - FINAL MARK SUM = 480 MARKS OR HIGHER







- Up to 5 program choices
 - Max 3 at one school

Requirements

- Grade 12 College (4C) or University (4U) English
- Some programs will require other courses (grade 11/12 math or 11/12 sciences)
- Some programs require a certain number of grade 11 or 12 courses at the C/M/U level
- NOTE: some colleges offer degree Programs -THESE require 6 u/m level courses in order to apply

College Deadlines

SEPTEMBER 30, 2023

APPLICATIONS OPEN

NOVEMBER 1, 2023

COLLEGES MAY START TO SEND EARLY OFFERS OF ADMISSION

February 1, 2024

The deadline for your application to be equally considered with all other applications

May 1, 2024

Most offers of admission must be confirmed

June 2024

Tuition deposits due to secure spot at college

UNIVERSITY **BOUND?**



Must have ENG4U1

(ENL1W1 -> ENG2D-> NBE3U)

Plus, Five additional 4U/4M Credits

So minimum requirement is SIX 4U/4M credits to be eligible





PUAC Ontario Universities' Application Centre

University Requirements

- Grade 12 University English (ENG4U1)
- Plus 5 other University (4U) or university/College Courses (4M)
- Total of 6 4U or 4M Gr. 12 courses
- Approx. Minimum average is 70% but many programs require higher
- Check with each institution and program

- Pre-Requisite courses are always used for admission
- Grade 11 marks may be used for Early acceptance
- See www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca for last year's admission averages or Ask the university





OUAC Fee \$156

- NEW THIS YEAR NO pin required!
- Base application Fee \$156 for 3 programs
- Each Additional Choice is \$50
 (No Fee for replacing a program Choice at the Same University)
- Max 3 Choices at any one university
- Supplemental Fees at Some Schools



University Deadlines

SEPTEMBER 21, 2023

APPLICATION CYCLE BEGINS

January 15, 2024

The deadline for your application to be equally considered with all other applications

May 29, 2024

Deadline to receive an offer of admission if you applied by January 15.

DUAC Ontario Universities' Application Centre

June 3, 2024

Many universities require a response to an Offer of admission (check offer of admission for specific deadlines)

Note: Residence Deposits likely due in May or June

Taking Credits other than Day School

- Inform Guidance if you are taking a course at night school or outside the Durham District School board
- Only courses taken at Maxwell Heights are automatically added to your Application
- YOU MUST PROVIDE a hard copy of the report card from schools outside the DDSB



FULL DISCLOSURE

- Transcripts show ALL:
 - All grade 9 and 10 passed courses
 - All grade 11 and 12 courses taken (passed or failed)
 - This includes multiple attempts
- Full Disclosure DATES for 2023-24 occur 5 days after midterm reports:
 - Semester 1 November 23, 2023 Semester 2 late April
- Guidance will confirm actual dates once the reporting cycle is released

Mark Upload Dates

1. October 4 (Demographics)

- 2. November 16 (Midterms)
 - This is before full disclosure
- 3. February 14 (Semester 1 Finals)

- 4. April 24 (Midterms)
 - This is before full disclosure

5. July 3 (Semester 2 Finals)

- 6. August 8 (Summer School Finals)
 - Past most schools deadlines
 - Must notify College/University as some may not accept

English Proficiency

IMPORTANT:

If you have been educated outside of Ontario in the last 4 years, you may be required to write an English Proficiency Test

- Check Test and Institution Due Dates
- Check which tests are approved for each Institution

What is **OSAP**? Ontario Student Assistance Program

- OSAP is a government funded program to help pay for college and university
- OSAP offers funding through GRANTS (do not have to pay back) or LOANS (repay once done school)
- How much money you can get depends on: personal financial situation, program/course load, and education expenses.
- Students apply directly on the OSAP website; applications usually open in spring 2024

Scholarships and Bursaries

Schools Based Scholarships

- Admission (University) Based off Admission Average No application
- Special Scholarships Different Criteria Application Often Required
- Check institution for details or ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca

School Based Bursaries

- Based on Financial need
- Usually requires you to apply to OSAP
- Disclosure of Financial Status
- Check institution for details or ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca

Private Bursaries and Scholarships

They set the criteria...some require essays, applications, grades, program choice

Applying For Scholarships

- Follow the Due Dates Write them down on a calendar
- Seek References Give lots of notice and help them with background info
- Seek Nominations from Guidance, if necessary
- Order Transcripts from Ms. Bisschop in guidance
- Follow the directions implicitly
- Read the Scholarship Report for Application Tips
