# COURSE SELECTIONS 2025/2026

## Asynchronous eLearning Courses

Students are required to complete two online learning credits as part of the 30 credits required for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). It applies to students who entered grade 9 on or after September 1, 2020. Although students working towards an Ontario Secondary School Certificate (OSSC) or Certificate of Accomplishment are not required to complete this new graduation requirement they may take eLearning courses.

The graduation requirement is intended to support students in developing familiarity and comfort with learning and working in a fully online environment, as well as developing digital literacy and other important transferable skills that they will need for success after secondary school, including in post-secondary education and the workplace.

Students selecting Asynchronous eLearning courses may select up to 8 eLearning courses.

To add an eLearning course, students need select the course in their Blueprint High School Planner

- Select the Asynchronous List of courses
- Select ELERN1
- Select the specific course from the drop-down menu (ie. BAF3ME)

Parents/guardians may choose to opt their child out of the mandatory online courses required for graduation. Students age 18 years of age or older or students who are 16 or 17 years of age and have withdrawn from parental control can also opt out of the graduation requirement. School boards must also allow for students and parents/guardians to opt back into the online learning graduation requirement should their decision change.
