





- You can sequence different leveled courses
 - Semester 1 **Applied** and Semester 2 **Academic**
 - Semester 1 <u>College/mixed</u> and semester 2 <u>University</u>
- PREREQUISITES A COURSE YOU NEED BEFORE TAKING ANOTHER COURSE (MCR3U1 BEFORE MHF4U1)
- Full Disclosure
 - All grade 11 and 12 courses attempted will be shown on transcript
