

- Grade 9-11: 80% PLUS AVERAGE IN TOP 8 COURSES FROM JULY 1, 2024 TO JUNE 25, 2025
 - FINAL MARK SUM = 640 MARKS OR HIGHER

Commencement Day

- Graduates are to arrive at 9:00 am
 - Please do not be late!
- Enter through Gate 1 (Northwest Doors)
 - No outside food or beverages are allowed into the venue
- From Gate 1
 - Graduates will proceed downstairs
 - Guests must go upstairs no exceptions



Parking

- Lots of paid parking around the venue

- Parking lot at 71 Bruce Street, just south of the venue

Cap and Gown

Once graduates are downstairs

- You are not permitted to leave
- You will receive your Cap and Gown
- You are to report to your designated marshalling area based on Preferred Last name
- *(Please pay attention to the signs)

Marshalling

- In the marshalling area, you will receive your reader card
 - This card will help you get and stay in order
 - You will give this card to the reader when you get to the stage
 - DO NOT lose it, leave it at your seat, fold or crumple it
- Visit the washroom and make your final Cap and Gown adjustments before 9:45 am
 - Students must stay in their assigned area while waiting for the ceremony to begin
- All will be assembled in line at 9:45 am



If you:


- Prefer a different name other than your Preferred Name be read

Entering the Arena PROCESSIONAL

- There will be a bag piper playing music as you are marshalled in
- Graduates will be guided into the seating area by Maxwell Teachers (marshals)
- The marshal will guide you to what row to sit in
- Once you are inside, and at your seat, please do not sit down until after the singing of 'O Canada'





Follow the instructions and stay in order

- It is very important that you remain as organized by your marshal
- Students will be organized into different sections to allow smooth transitions during the ceremony

CROSSING THE STAGE




Going to the Stage for your Diploma



- Remain in your seat until motioned by a teacher
- The teacher will motion when your row is to stand and approach to stage.
- Students will go up on the right side via the ramp
- You will pass your reader card to a teacher at the top of the ramp

Stage



- wait until your name is called to begin to walk across the stage
- When your name is called you will come to centre stage, where the presenter is
- You will receive your diploma scroll with your Right Hand plus any other awards that you may have earned/won

Leaving the stage




 Once you have your scroll, please leave the stage area via the exit ramp (left side of stage)

Photo



- Stop to have your photo taken
 - Students will be given a unique code to access the photo online (24 hours after ceremony)

Getting your Diploma




- Stop to pick up your diploma envelope at table
- If you ordered a composite photo, you collect it here as well
- Follow the teacher to return to your original seat

Leaving the Arena RECESSIONAL

- At the end of the ceremony, you will be asked to stand for the Recessional
- Once the platform party and staff leaves, graduates will be motioned to begin to leave the arena
- You will exit your seating 1 row at a time





Meeting with your guests and other graduates

Once you leave the arena area, staff will guide you to the Exit (Gate 1) where you can meet up with your guests

There will be photo opportunities in the main concourse area at the top of the stairs


